As we continue through this longer-term closure, as promised, I will continue providing updates.

School Meal Service

Just a reminder, even with the stay at home order, families can still participate in the pick up meal service Monday-Friday at the high school gym between 11:00 am and 12:15 pm for all children age 18 and under.

Blocked or Private Phone Calls

We are asking parents to consider answering Blocked or Private Calls during the closure if possible, starting next week our teachers will be calling students more often and have been having a tough time connecting with their students to assist in instruction, especially if there is no voice mail option.

Report Cards

We are working on closing out the 3rd marking period based on the roughly 40 days of the marking period students completed. Those report cards will be posted next week for both elementary secondary students.

We are awaiting information from the Pennsylvania Department of Education on guidelines for the 4th marking period.

Dual Enrollment Classes

I have been in communication with our dual enrollment universities and am waiting to hear how they are addressing the closure. As soon as I have more information, I will let students and families know.

8th & 9th Grade Class Fundraiser - Pickup for the Powerhouse Sub sale has been postpone until further notice.


