Moshannon Valley Students, Families, and Staff:

I am heartbroken to make this announcement, shortly after 10:00 am this morning, Governor Wolf notified districts he has ordered the closure all public schools through the end of the 2019-2020 academic year, as defined by the local school calendar. There are several things that come about as a result of that statement. First, our school calendar ends on June 4, 2020 and that will serve as the end of our school year and we will continue to current online learning programs for the remainder of April and the month of May.

Second, all official school events including Prom, School Plays, Sports Banquet, and Baccalaureate have been postponed until further notice.

Third, all field trips scheduled for this spring will be cancelled and will not be rescheduled.

Food service will continue Monday-Friday after the Easter holiday for all children 18 years of age and under. Pick up at the high school gym entrance from 11:00 am - 12:15 pm.

Finally, I will be meeting Via Google Meet with the Senior Class and Senior Families next week to discuss the options available to us for graduation. We will get more information on when that meeting will take place after the Easter holiday.

I know this announcement will prompt more questions than it answers, the District administration will be meeting next week and will be working to provide answers to all questions. In the meantime, please plan to continue our academic schedules as have been communicated previously for the remainder of the school year.
