Moshannon Valley Families, Students, and Staff,

Today at 2:00 pm, Governor Wolf, PDE and DOH announced an Order signed by Pennsylvania's Acting Secretary of Health requiring face coverings to be worn, while inside all school entities, including school districts, brick and mortar and cyber charter schools, private and parochial schools, career and technical centers, intermediate units, and early learning and other child care settings, effective Tuesday, September 7, 2021.

Consistent with this mandate and consistent with Moshannon Valley's June 21, 2021, School Board Approved Health and Safety Plan, which states:

The District will follow all masking requirements as mandated by PDE, DOH, CDC, and/or other authoritative agencies, for all district facilities and transportation.

As of Tuesday, September 7th, all Moshannon Valley students, staff, and visitors, regardless of vaccination status, will be required to wear a face covering while indoors, including spectators at inside events. While we understand the frustration associated with this directive, we appreciate everyone's support. The goal for Moshannon Valley is to remain in school, and to ensure that our athletics and extra-curricular activities continue.
