Additional Factors that may be considered:

- Case Counts in County and Local Area
- Increased Staff Absences and the Inability to Provide Instruction Safely
- Increased Bus Contractor Absences and the Inability to Transport Students in a Safe Manner

School closures will permit time for response protocols for communication, public health engagement, contact tracing, quarantine, cleaning, and recovery as outlined in the District's School Reopen Plan and as directed by the Pennsylvania Department of Health.

School or District Closures will mean that all students in the designated school, or district, will learn remotely on days that schools are closed.
