I want to thank you for your tremendous patience and support during this challenging year. The District wanted to share an update on End-of-the-Year activities based on all information available at this time. With so many events lost last year, ensuring that we can hold all events this year is paramount for our students, staff, and families. We understand that there is no perfect schedule, please know that we have considered numerous options and have been very intentional about the schedule with the primary focus of remaining at school for in-person instruction to the greatest extent possible.

With the changes, we wanted to provide everyone with as much time as possible to plan for events, and as a result, we are releasing this information in March.

While fluctuations in occupancy limits may occur, we do not anticipate significant enough changes to allow for graduation and other larger events to move indoors. Therefore, the following schedule will be in place for the events outlined:

- **Tuesday, May 18:** Academic Awards & Scholarships – Virtual (Same at 2020)
- **Thursday, May 20:** Music Awards & Concert (Band & Choir) – Football Field – 4 Tickets per student

- **Monday, May 24:** Baccalaureate - Gym – 2 Tickets per student
 - Will also be streamed
- **Tuesday, May 25:** All-Sports Awards Ceremony
 - Juniors & Seniors only, no meal – 2 tickets per student
 - Will also be streamed with all grade seven through twelve athletes being recognized
- **Wednesday, June 2:** Last Day of School – 1:00 pm Dismissal
- **Thursday, June 3:** Prom (High School Gym & Cafeteria Rain or Shine)
 - Outside Grand March 6:00 pm using Graduation Stage (Weather Permitting)
- **Friday, June 4:** Freshman Dance (High School Gym Rain or Shine)
 - Outside Grand March 6:00 pm Using Graduation Stage (Weather Permitting)
- **Saturday, June 5:** Graduation 12:00 pm (High School Parking Lot)
 - Outside same as 2020 with graduate and 2 guests seated in front
 - Additional 4 tickets per student for seating area
 - Overflow permitted to view from their vehicles

- **Saturday, June 5:** 6th Grade Graduation 3:30 pm (High School Parking Lot)
 - Outside same as 2020 with graduate and 2 guests seated in front
 - Additional 4 tickets per student for seating area
- **Saturday, June 5:** 6th Grade Dance 4:30 – 6:30 pm (High School Gym rain or shine)
- **Sunday, June 6:** Graduation Rain Date 2:00 pm Start
- **Sunday, June 6:** 6th Grade Graduation Rain Date 5:00 pm Start
