

# Moshannon Valley Back to School Food Service Plan 2020-2021

## Welcome Back!

The following tentative plan for meal service is for the 2020-2021 school year. Please keep in mind that these plans could change at any given moment in order to comply with state mandated regulations.

**Menus** for Breakfast and Lunch can be found on the school website, or by downloading the **Nutrislice** App to your smart phone.

### Breakfast:



- Students who arrive by bus will enter the building anytime 7:45 am or after
- A Grab n Go breakfast will be available
- **Elementary:** in the hall outside the cafeteria
- **Secondary:** at two locations, the main entrance and the Collaboration Cafe
- **There will not be any alternate choices offered at breakfast**
- Students will receive their meal and report to their assigned area where they can eat their breakfast or choose to wait until they get to their classroom
- Students with private transportation will begin to enter the building at 8:05
- **Elementary:** Receive their breakfast and report directly to their assigned room
- **Secondary:** Receive their breakfast and report directly to 1st period

### Lunch:

- **Elementary:** Lunches will be delivered daily to each classroom
  - Teachers will do a daily sheet to be sent to the cafeteria with student lunch orders
  - Students may choose the Hot Entrée, or the Cold Entrée, and skim, white, or chocolate milk
  - Students who pack will still be able to get milk if they'd like
  - K-1 lunch will be delivered at 10:50
  - 2-3 Lunch will be delivered at 11:30
  - 4-6 Lunch will be delivered at 12:10
- **Secondary:** Lunches will be in the cafeteria, auditorium, & alternate locations as needed
  - Students may choose the Hot Entrée, or the Cold Entrée, or Pizza, and skim, white, or chocolate milk
  - **Scanners** have been added this year to streamline check out. Each high school student will receive a Scan Code Use the personal Scan Code Card, or download your Code from the Skyward App, by choosing MENU, FULL MENU, ID CARD
- Every meal will include a fruit and vegetable
- The alternate cold meal will rotate between a Ham & Cheese Sandwich, Turkey & Cheese Sandwich, or a Breaded Chicken Salad depending on what is being offered that week.



In the event that the District transitions to the yellow phase with 50% of students attending, students would be provided the option to order meals to take home and student accounts would be charged based on student status as regular, reduced, or free lunch for those meals.
